- Entry requirements
- Visa requirements
- Proxy permission



3. ACCEPT OFFER

Submit all required documents, signed LoO and signed visa form through our online application portal.

Once payment has been confirmed, you will be sent the CoE by email along with information on:

- Your Overseas Student Health Cover policy
- Orientation Day information
- Things to know before moving to Canberra
