APPROXIMATE EXTRA FEES

Diploma: Materials fee \$1,529, hard drive or cloud storage \$100, stationery and printing \$200, laptop (preferred but not essential) e.g. MacBook Pro \$3,000.

Advanced Diploma: Hard drive \$100, printing and mounting \$320, laptop (preferred but not essential) e.g. Macbook Pro \$3,000.

INDUSTRY PLACEMENT

While industry placement is not a course requirement, CIT's connections to industry may provide opportunities for students to undertake unpaid work placements.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Year 12 Certificate (or equivalent) or Adult Entry
- **English requirement:** IELTS Academic 6.0 (no band score less than 5.0) or PTE Academic 50 (minimum of 36 in each band)
- **LLN:** LLN test (administered by CIT International) with Australian Core Skills Framework literacy levels of at least 4 in reading, writing, learning, oral communication and numeracy
- A portfolio of recent work or work that demonstrates your aptitude for design.
