## APPROXIMATE EXTRA FEES

**Diploma:** Material fees \$5,900, uniform/equipment \$500, immunisation costs \$350, textbooks \$150, First Aid training \$200, Police check from the Australian Federal Police \$56, Working With Vulnerable People check \$135.

## INDUSTRY PLACEMENT

Mandatory clinical industry placement experience (minimum 400 unpaid hours in total) will be provided in areas such as acute care, aged care, mental health rehabilitation, community nursing, diabetic and wound clinics, primary health and palliative care.

The hours generally are broken up into blocks of 1 week, 2 weeks or 3 weeks throughout the 3 semesters.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Year 12 Certificate (or equivalent) or Adult Entry
- **English requirement:** AHPRA updated English requirements for Nursing on 23 April 2026. Minimum scores differ depending on your test date. Accepted tests: IELTS Academic, PTE Academic, Cambridge C1/C2, OET, or TOEFL iBT.
- **LLND:** LLND test (administered by CIT International) with Australian Core Skills Framework literacy levels of at least 4 in reading, writing, learning, oral communication and numeracy.
